Secretary's Report

Dear FBSIAP Colleagues,

Greetings from Family Benefit Scheme of IAP Office Hyderabad!

On the occasion of Landmark and Milestone day of both IAP and FBS, I communicate to you with following recapitulations and thoughts. And it gives me great pleasure in presenting to all the FBS IAP members and the Managing Committee of FBSIAP a brief update and background of the very popular and successful Members welfare Scheme FBS of IAP from the year of inception 2011 to 2012.

The concept of launching a first time welfare scheme for the Members of IAP was put on agenda during Executive Body meeting in June 2010 at Srinagar under the than President ship of Dr Deepak Ugra and Hon. Secretary General` s tenure of Dr Tanmay Amladi by the President - Elect Dr T U Sukumaran under the IAP action Plan for the year 2011. The similar proposal was also proposed by the IAP members of Andhra Pradesh through the Executive Committee Member Dr Ajoy Kumar during the same meeting. The EB passed the proposal for further action.

A drafting Committee for the bye-laws was constituted, after many deliberations and borrowing from various other sister professional organizations, a initial bye-laws were presented at Jaipur Pedicon 2011 Executive Body meeting ,which passed the Family benefit Scheme for AGM consideration. The AGM held at Jaipur passed and ratified the same and the Scheme FBS IAP was born.

Initially, All India Managing Committee of FBS along with Team Hyderabad was formed with 3-years tenure by CIAP. The Scheme was launched formally at Hyderabad on 27th March 2011 by Dr T U Sukumaran, President 2011, in distinguished presence of Dr Rohit Agrawal President 2012. Chairman Dr George Moollayil and Dr Tanmay Amladi other dignitaries and members of IAP from and outside AP. An exclusive website was also inaugurated in technical collaboration with Mr Rajeev Ravulapati of Tec Hub Pvt Ltd.

A FBSIAP office was established, furnished, automated and staffed at the place freely given by IAP member Dr M Surendranath, for daily operations at Hyderabad. The Society was registered and a Bank account was opened for its activities by name "Family Benefit Society" under the IAP Umbrella. A Chartered accountant, M/S V.S Ganesh & Co. was also appointed. And from the first day onwards it started with blazing speed to reach a 1000 figure in a short period. The first distribution of FBS membership certificate was done ceremoniously and symbolically during Mumbai EB meeting in June 2011 itself to the Chairman FBS Dr George Moolayil as first Member, EB member Dr Remesh Kumar and President Dr T U Sukumaran himself .The first baby steps of the FBS begun well.

The FBS Certificate is unique in the sense; it gives many relevant details of the member along with a Special security feature of hologram with laser engraved matching numbering.

The Hyderabad managing Team along with its Advisers Dr M Indrashekar Rao, Dr Arumugam, Dr P Sudershan Reddy, Dr P Venkateshwar Rao and Dr Sanjay Srirampur, met frequently to discuss and thrash out administrative and Members issues on regular basis. The first all India Managing Committee meeting was held on 27th November 2011 at Hyderabad.

Proposals for amendments in bye-laws to make the Scheme more attractive to young IAP members also was made at the EB meeting in Gurgaon, basing on the feed backs, review of response of enrollments and forwarded by AIMC.

The Second AI MC of FBS IAP was held at @ Gurgaon PEDICON in January 2012

First FBS IAP AGM was held @ Gurgaon during PEDICON 2012 on 21st January. Graced by the entire IAP National President's 2011, 2012 and 2013 - Dr T U Sukumaran, Dr Rohit Agrawal and Dr C P Bansal respectively along with the FBS Chairman Dr George Moolayil, Vigilance Officer Dr Dhananjay Shah, Treasurer & Joint Secretary Dr Surendranath, Office bearers and FBSIAP members. More feathers added in the membership of FBS by enrollment of OB of CIAP.

Member friendly Amendments were passed and ratified at Gurgaon AGM for founder members and regular members etc. A special mention was made by the President Dr Rohit Agrawal to look after the interest of senior IAP members also, in his address.

FBS Stall was put up in the PEDICON 2012 Gurgaon, courtesy Chairman Dr Ramesh Goyalji and Secretary Dr M P Jain of Organizing Committee PEDICON 2012. The facility for spot registration with Rs 1000/- as advance to encourage and simplify enrollment procedure at door step was given as suggested in the Gurgaon EBM during the Conference. A good response was noticed esp. from EB Members.

Flood of application started pouring in FBS IAP office Hyderabad just before and after deadline for “founder members” category in March 2012.

Articles with Constitution, bye-laws and application forms and gist with appeal of FBSIAP published in Academy Today and Indian Pediatrics in 2011 and 2012. I whole heartedly thank Dr Piyush Gupta, Editor-in-Chief IP and Dr Nedunchelian, Editor-in-Chief IJPP and Dr Sailesh Gupta, Secretary General CIAP for their unstinted support.

Full page black and white advertisement was published continuously every month, from September 2011 in Journal of Indian Pediatrics and subsequently in Indian Journal of Practical Pediatrics till date

Website constructed, up dated and running with comprehensive information of FBSIAP hosted at www.FBSIAP.org. All the accepted members have been issued user ID and passwords for access of their individual page. Unique feature of website is individual account and page created to look and manage FBSIAP member's information dues and payments and other details

The website is now shifted and hosted on our own IAP server. A Link was also given in Home page of Indian Academic of Pediatrics, which was highlighted for sometime during launch. Thanks to CIAP and webmaster Dr Amit Shah.

A record of sorts in enrollment of membership was created compared to all sister organizations' with similar schemes in India. Around 1000 members joined in first year of launch of the Scheme. Lot more to be done still in the long journey for achieving at least 5000 members as soon as possible (Rs 15 lakhs benefit)

A fresh demand by new applicants, EB Members to extend the date for founder membership Category up to 31 March 2013 was put forward. Recommendation from EBM held at Goa June 2012 for extension up to 31 March 2013 was also suggested. Hyderabad Team was pleased to forward the same to AIMC to take the final decision on this matter. Subsequently Hyderabad Team and All India MC favored the proposal and put forward the same to AGM of FBSIAP for final decision to be held at Kolkota PEDICON 2013, in January 2013. Till then applicants admitted provisionally at old fees structure who have applied after 26th March 2012 is being enrolled.

This Annual report of the FBSIAP is being released with activities and details about the scheme and members, accounts and other useful information now. I thank the DGM of State Bank of Hyderabad for sponsoring printing and posting of the Annual report for the years 2011 and 2012.

Promotional and awareness activities of FBSIAP all over India to IAP members was done by CIAP, all the MC members and EB members with special thanks for the same to Dr Vasant khalatkar, Dr Harinder Singh, Dr Somu Siva balan, Dr Ramesh kumar, Dr Bipin Shah, Dr Dhananjay Shah, Dr Om Prakash Shukla, Dr Suresh Sarma, Dr Mallesh Gowda, Dr Ram Narsimha Reddy, Dr S S Kamath, Dr Sudhakar and many more in their respective states and from All over India. But more vigor and motivation of IAP members is needed to join the scheme, in large numbers.

A draft time table is proposed for the year of FBS for Action plan. All the applications and relevant documents are being digitized and stored in electronic form, with handing over of copy to CIAP is undergoing.

I am deeply indebted to CIAP President Dr Rohit Agrawal, Dr C P Bansal, Dr T U Sukumaran and Dr Sailesh Gupta, Dr Pravin J Mehta Chairman FBS Dr George F Moolayil, All India MC and Team Hyderabad. I thank Dr M Surendranath, Joint Secretary and Treasurer of FBS for his help and hard work. I also thank Dr Neeli Ramchander, Dr N Ravi Kumar and Dr P Durga Prasad for their support.



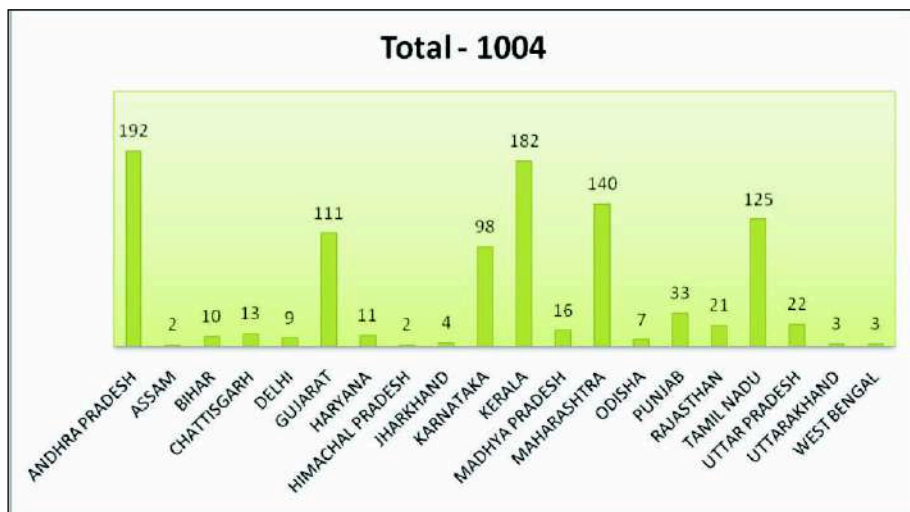

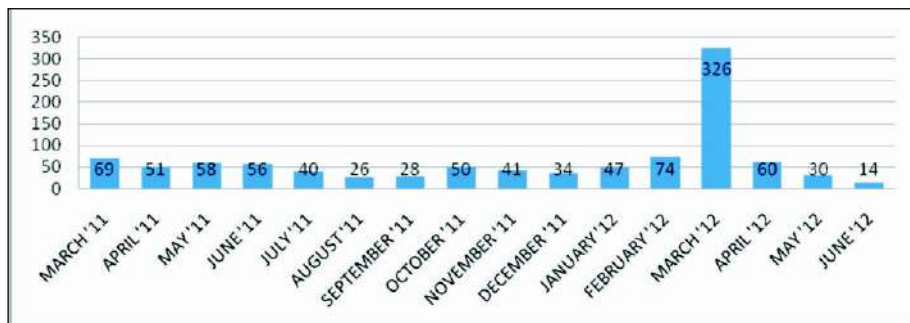

FBS-IAP Membership Enrollments as on 10-07-2012



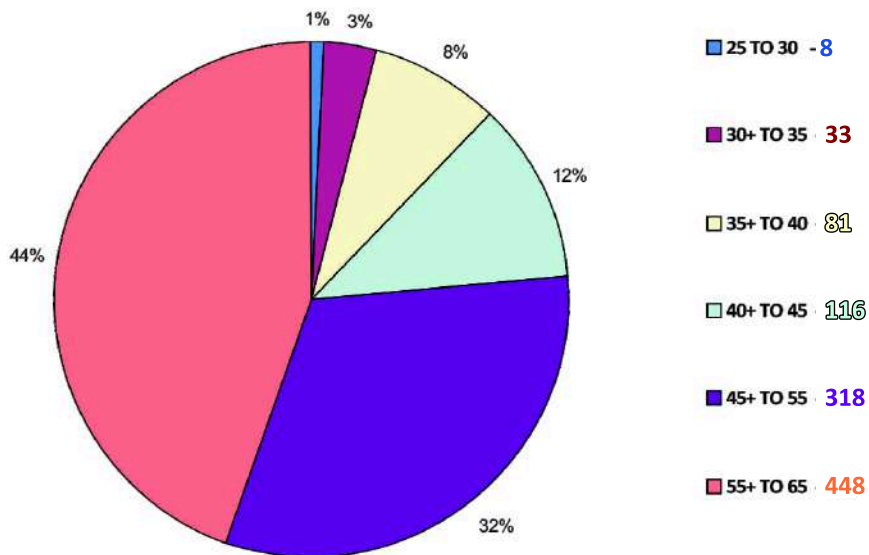
Applications State wise

Family Benefit Scheme of IAP

- ❑ “Founder Members”, who have joined the Scheme on or before 26.03.2012 (**Proposed 31.03.2013**) have to pay Fraternity Contribution for 20 years only.
- ❑ “Regular Members”, who enroll in the Scheme after 26.03.2012 (**Proposed from 01.04.2013**) have to pay Fraternity Contribution for 25 years only.

Joining Fee

For Age between 25+ to 30 Years – Rs. 5,000/-

For Age between 30+ to 35 Years – Rs. 7,500/-

For Age between 35+ to 40 Years – Rs. 10,000/-

For Age between 40+ to 45 Years – Rs. 12,500/-

For Age between 45+ to 55 Years – Rs. 15,000/-

For Age between 55+ to 65 Years – Rs. 15,000/-

Proposed changes from 01.04.2013

New slab and Joining Fee

For Age between 55+ to 60 Years – Rs. 30,000/-

Proposals for FBS - AGM 2013

- ❑ To extend the date of enrollment of Founder Members to 31st March, 2013 to all applicants.
- ❑ The same rate of Rs.15000/- as Joining Fee will be applicable to those members between 55+ to 65 years of age, who enrolls in the Scheme on or before 31.03.2013 and have to pay Fraternity Contribution for 20 years only.
- ❑ All completed applications received till the evening of 31st March, 2013 will be considered for accepting as Founder Members, including full payment.
- ❑ The new age slabs, rules and fee structures will be applicable as the Regular Members who enroll from 1st April 2013.

Fraternity Contribution

Fraternity Contribution Bill will be raised once in a year on 30th September. Advance Fraternity of Rs. 10,000/- can also be paid for future adjustments.

Every member of the Scheme shall pay Contribution of Rs. 360/- (Rs. 300 + Future Liability Fund of Rs. 60 {i.e 20% of DBF}) per death of IAP members in the Scheme. The amount calculated accordingly to the number of Members who expired in one year. The amount thus collected from the members of the Scheme will be paid after verifying the claim to the Nominee of the members who have expired.



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
